



CALL FOR NOMINATIONS
2011 ICTP Prize

The Selection Committee for the 2011 ICTP Prize is now accepting nominations. This year's Prize will honour a young scientist working in the fields of physics or mathematics.

To be eligible, a candidate should be no more than 40 years old on 31 December 2011. He/She should be a national of a developing country, working and living there -- though sabbaticals and similar absences from the home country are acceptable. The ICTP Prize was created in 1982 by the ICTP Scientific Council to recognise outstanding contributions in physics and mathematics. Since then the Prize has gained prestige and is now regarded quite highly. The Prize includes a sculpture (previously a medal), certificate and a cash award of Euro 3000.

The nomination should include the vitae of the candidate including date of birth, a brief account of the work and proposed citation, at least two letters of recommendation and a list of important publications.
